

Proposal for a performance work at
Sergels Torg, Stockholm
Open call by the Public Art agency of Sweden 2016

A Night Concert; Small town to the capital city Stockholm.
Jönköping Chamber Choir singing the lyrics and music of
Annika Ström

In the autumn of 2015, I made a performance with
Jönköping Chamber Choir with the conductor Ove Gotting.
The chamber choir performed texts, short phrases, the
phrases that appeared on billboards around the Jonkoping
and digital road signs on highway E4 nearby.

A concert was performed at the City café in Jonkoping and
filmed.

The music is composed by me and arranged by Ove
Gotting.

This works, I wanted to pass on to a larger scale, in the
big city, at night in a darkened Sergels torg square.

The members of the choir would stand silent and be
encircled by 50 loud skateboards with lanterns on wheels
and on hoods. Riders would vanish away slowly.

When the sounds of the noisy boards were removed, light
falls on the choir.

The conductor Ove Gotting parachutes down to the
chorus (possible; A stunt)

The conductor begins directing and Skateboards skaters
are quiet and with lights off a short distance away.

The texts projected on house facades around while the
choir in front of the texts.

When the choir is silent the skaters lights their lights on
the boards again and rings in the choir by going around
them. The lights go out.

The concert last approximately 15 minutes.
